

WELCOME TO HOCKEY ACADEMY

Welcome to Hockey Academy!
This academy is designed for skaters who have an interest in playing hockey and would like to develop the necessary skills to be able to participate in a hockey program.

Skaters are required to have participated in our Learn-to-Skate program and have completed (evaluation sheets will indicate when the skater has passed the level) classes through the Pre-Alpha class.

Skaters will develop and improve their skating skills and receive proper training on playing related skills such as: stick handling, puck handling, and shooting. Skaters in this academy will typically be between 6-13 years old.
